# Minors Participating in Wenatchee Valley College Continuing Education Classes

Wenatchee Valley College Continuing Education classes are designed for adult learners. However, some Continuing Education classes may be available to minors. Please contact us (ceinfo@wvc.edu or 509.682.6900) to determine if a class is eligible.

This policy describes the requirements for minors to enroll and participate in **eligible** WVC Continuing Education classes. This policy does not apply to classes that are specifically designed for children/minors.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- a. Minors aged 16-17 may enroll in <u>eligible</u> continuing education classes with the required release form and are subject to the conditions outlined in this policy.
   For minors ages 16-17, a parent or legal guardian must be reachable and available by phone during the
  - duration of all class meetings.
- b. Minors between the ages of 14 and 15 may enroll in <u>eligible</u> classes <u>with a parent/guardian registered and attending the same class(es)</u>. The release form is required.
- c. Minors must meet any prerequisites or other eligibility criteria specified for the particular course they wish to enroll in.
- d. Minors under 14 years of age may enroll ONLY in classes specifically designed for that age group.

### PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT

- a. A signed permission and waiver form from the parent/legal guardian is required for minors under the age of 18 to participate in **eligible** WVC Continuing Education classes.
  - a. The signed permission/waiver form must be submitted to WVC Continuing Education **prior to registration**. Seats will not be saved in classes while paperwork is completed.
- b. Parent/guardian will acknowledge that Wenatchee Valley College:
  - Is a college, and is an adult environment
  - Does not require instructors to monitor student attendance
  - Does not provide extra supervision or monitoring of its students
  - Is comprised of students from a wide range of age groups, backgrounds, cultures and experiences. Some students may have criminal records which may not be known to WVC staff.
  - Is an institute of higher learning that may expose students to varying ideas, concepts, philosophies, and material that some may not view as suitable for younger students.

#### STUDENT CONDUCT

- a. Minors participating in continuing education classes are expected to behave in a mature, responsible manner in a class of adults.
- Class disruption may result in expulsion from the course at the discretion of the instructor and WVC Continuing Education.

#### **EMERGENCY**

a. Emergency contact information provided by the parent/guardian will be used to communicate any urgent matters relating to the minor's participation in continuing education classes.
