Running Start Equivalency/Requirements

Running Start students need to fulfill all graduation requirements set by LBHS to earn their diploma. College credits are converted to LBHS credits at a 5:1 ratio, meaning that five college credits count as one LBHS credit. It's important for students to meet with their high school counselor each quarter before they register for college classes.

To be eligible for graduation, all necessary coursework for Liberty Bell High School **must be finished by the end of the winter quarter.**
